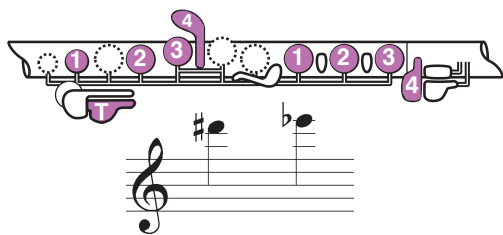
How to Play 42 Notes on the Flute

more than three octaves higher.**

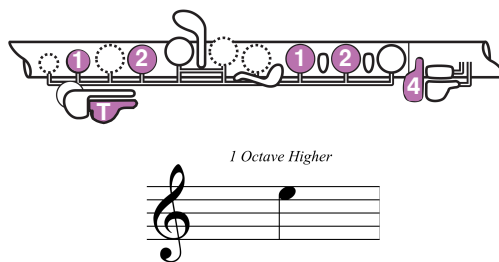
